In that connection, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Coimbatore imposed a fine of Rs. 30,000 on the Company. The fine was paid by the Company as directed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate. The original copy of the Court Order was received today through the Company's Attorney and hence the intimation is being made today.

Nature and details of the action(s) taken, initiated or order(s) passed.	A contract worker sustained an injury while gathering sand from a sand mixer on 22.02.2023. The accident was reported to the Joint Director of Industrial Safety and Health (DISH), Coimbatore. Company paid full salary to the injured contract worker for the days he was absent to work and reimbursed all the medical expenses incurred by him at the hospital. Necessary corrective action was also taken at the accident site.
	The Company received summons' from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Coimbatore, to which the Company's representative appeared for the hearings. At the final hearing on March 11, 2024, the Chief Judicial Magistrate imposed a fine of Rs. 30,000 on the Company. The fine was paid by the Company on March 11, 2024, as directed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate but a written and certified order to that effect was not made available on that day. The original copy of the Court Order was received today, 25-4-24, through the Company's Attorney.
Date of receipt of direction or order, including any ad-interim or interim orders, or any other communication from the authority.	The Company received the Chief Judicial Magistrate's order through its Attorney on April 25, 2024.
